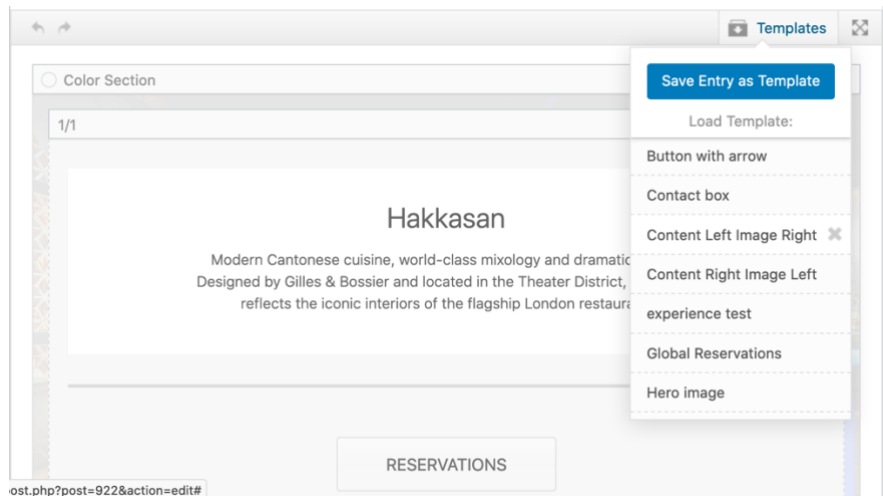


Adding Content Blocks to Hakkasan Restaurant Location Pages

1. Select “Templates” on the top right of the Avia Builder and choose between:
 - Content **Left** Image **Right**
 - Content **Right** Image **Left**

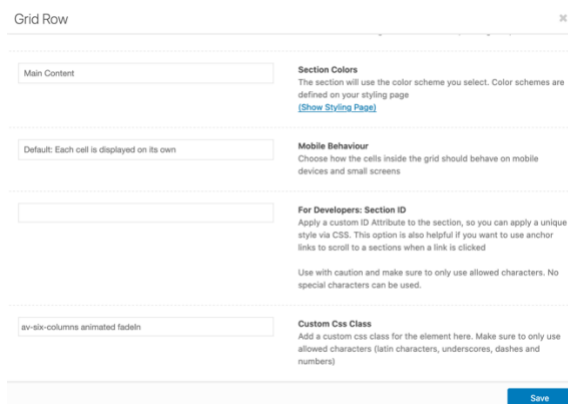


2. The block template will be added at the *bottom* of the page. Drag the “Grid Row” to the space where you need it to appear on the front-end, above or below other blocks.
3. Adjust content as necessary. Do not adjust custom CSS tags or any options other than text areas.

Ensure settings are as follows. You can adjust these settings by clicking the  button in the top left of the block.

Content Left/Image Right modules:

- Grid Row
 - Custom CSS Class: “**av-six-columns animated fadeIn**”



- 1/1 Cell
 - Vertical Align: **Top**
 - Padding-Top: **120px**
 - Apply same value to all? **Checked**
 - Custom CSS Class: **shadows**

Main Content

Section Colors
The section will use the color scheme you select. Color schemes are defined on your styling page [\(Show Styling Page\)](#)

Default: Each cell is displayed on its own

Mobile Behaviour
Choose how the cells inside the grid should behave on mobile devices and small screens

For Developers: Section ID
Apply a custom ID Attribute to the section, so you can apply a unique style via CSS. This option is also helpful if you want to use anchor links to scroll to a sections when a link is clicked
Use with caution and make sure to only use allowed characters. No special characters can be used.

Row Settings

Please note: If you move another column into first position you will need to re-apply these settings.

Equal Height Columns
Columns in this row can either have a height based on their content or all be of equal height based on the largest column

Space between columns
You can remove the default space between columns here.

Custom top and bottom margin
If checked allows you to set a custom top and bottom margin. Otherwise the margin is calculated by the theme based on surrounding elements

Add a custom css class for the element here. Make sure to only use allowed characters (latin characters, underscores, dashes and numbers)

Image Guidelines:

- No images with white, grey, or similar near any border of image
- No square images. Landscape only.
- Ensure that “**Full size**” is selected under “Attachment Display Settings” or image will be pixelated, or otherwise unusable. Always use highest resolution, original images when possible.

- Darker images are preferred over lighter ones so the vignette can take effect.
